

Good Morning Church - 7th June 2026 - 10th in Ordinary Time

Welcome to the tenth Sunday in Ordinary Time. Ordinary Time is anything but ordinary. It is the season in which we learn what it means to follow Jesus day by day, discovering God's presence in the routines, challenges and opportunities of everyday life.

This week's readings tell stories of faith, trust and new beginnings. We hear God's call to Abram to step out into the unknown, trusting in a promise not yet fulfilled. Paul reminds us that faith is about trusting God's promises even when circumstances seem impossible. In the Gospel, Jesus calls Matthew from his tax booth and brings healing and hope to those who reach out to him in faith.

One verse that stands out is God's simple but powerful invitation to Abram:

"Go from your country and your kindred and your father's house to the land that I will show you." (Genesis 12:1)

God does not always reveal the whole journey in advance, but invites us to take the next faithful step. As we worship, pray and serve this week, may we have the courage to trust God's leading and discover anew the blessings that come from following Christ.
